EXPERIENCE IN DEVELOPMENT OF UNIVERSITY PEDAGOGY PROGRAMME

Since 1999, I've actively developed the Programme of the University Pedagogy (60 ECTS). At Mid90s, the Programme of the University Pedagogy consisted of Basic Studies in University Pedagogy (25 ECTS), and it was offered only as a one course every second year. I developed together with colleagues the Basic Studies to include 5 courses, and then starting 2003, the Subject Studies (35 ECTS) were first time offered to academic staff. Since 2009, the Programme of University Pedagogy (60 ECTS) has included the Teacher Qualification. The development of the Programme has based on continuous research by the academic staff of the Centre for Research and Development in Higher Education in cooperation with Pedagogical University Lecturers and members of Teachers' Academy. During the Big Wheel process, I developed the Programme of University Pedagogy (60 ECTS) together with my colleagues in the Centre for University Teaching and Learning to be aligned with other Teacher Qualification (60 ECTS) Programmes offered by the Faculty of Educational Sciences.
