Teaching Portfolio

I am originally from Tennessee and have been teaching Translation at the University of Helsinki since 1996. My scholarly books and articles have concentrated on Innovation in Education, Translation Teaching and Learning, and English Language Teaching (ELT), Japanese, American and Finnish Studies as well as Business and Organizational Communication. I hold the position of Docent (Adjunct Professor) of Applied English Translation Studies at the University of Helsinki and, from 2001 - 2016, Part-time Lecturer of International Business at Tampere University of Applied Science. I earned my BA in Political Science at the University of Tennessee, Knoxville, an MSc at Aston University, Birmingham, England and my Doctorate in Organizational Communication at the University of Jyväskylä, Finland. I have also been an Assistant Language Teacher in Japanese junior high schools through the Japan Exchange Teaching Program (CLAIR), a Japanese National Scholar (Monbusho) at Nara University of Education and Osaka University of Foreign Studies and have been a visiting professor at many institutions all over the world.

Statement of Teaching Philosophy

Like other practitioners in the field, my basic philosophy of language and translation teaching and learning has evolved, and will continue to do so, over the years. The guiding principle in my teaching is now social constructivism which emphasizes the importance of culture and context in understanding what occurs in society and constructing knowledge based on this understanding. In contemporary Finnish society, integrated computer technology plays a major role. I believe that translation teaching should incorporate ICT as mine does. In addition, I emphasize learner-centered teaching methods by encouraging on-going assessment of my teaching as well as direct input from the students as to materials and themes that my courses cover.

It is my belief that teachers should take charge of their own individual development as teachers, researchers, or administrators. The activities we as teachers are engaged in such as presenting new ideas at professional conferences, publishing research, participating in professional organizations and other activities have a significant impact on our work. Rather than viewing the development of teaching as the mastery of prevailing principles and theories that have been laid down by others, individual teachers should devise their own workable teaching models based on experience as both a teacher and learner of languages. Rather than just keep abreast of changes, we can lead them and find our own "niche" in the field of education. I feel my continual involvement in learning, teaching, training, materials development, and committee work over the last several years demonstrates my attitudes towards our profession.

Materials Production, Courses Taught and Student Feedback

I have developed materials for numerous courses over the years using Integrated Computer Technology (Moodle, Memsources, Wordfast and other programs and applications) and traditional materials production both in the form of handouts, PowerPoint presentations, and lectures. The great diversity in the courses that I have taught and the overwhelming satisfaction of the learners involved speaks for itself (see also below).
